Minalogic elects new Board:

Philippe Magarshack reelected President and Board of Directors expanded to sixteen representatives from across the region

Grenoble, France, May 31, 2016 – The Minalogic digital technology cluster held a meeting of its Board of Directors on May 13, 2016. Philippe Magarshack was reelected President and six Vice Presidents were elected. A vote to expand the Board of Directors to sixteen members was made at the Minalogic annual general meeting on March 29, 2016, to ensure more effective representation of Minalogic's technological and geographical scope. The vote aligns with the cluster's most recent strategic plan, its expansion into digital technologies, and its broader geographical footprint encompassing the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes region. An additional decision was made to increase the number of SME representatives on the Bureau to eight.

Board of Directors expanded to sixteen seats

The seats are broken down as follows: nine for businesses; six for institutions of higher education and research; and one for economic development and innovation support organizations.

Philippe Magarshack, Executive Vice President, **STMicroelectronics**, was reelected for a second two-year term as Minalogic's President.
